FERGUS FALLS HOSTS TOWN HALL TO RESPOND TO THE CHILDCARE SHORTAGE

The City of Fergus Falls is one of ten communities working with First Children's Finance and the Rural Child Care Innovation Program (RCCIP). This community engagement process includes exploring current workforce and demographic data to seek right-sized solutions to the child care shortage utilizing existing assets and creating new partnerships.
