

Items Accepted in Dumpsters and Roll-offs

Please note debris types cannot be mixed with other types

TYPE: Construction/Demolition Load

- Aggregate (concrete, brick, bituminous concrete, rock, etc.)
- Untreated wood and wood scraps
- Wood and pressed wood furniture
- Shingles
- Masonry
- Windows/glass
- Insulation
- Sheetrock/plaster
- Porcelain/ceramic plumbing parts
- Fiberglass (hot tubs, toppers, boats, etc.)

TYPE: Municipal Solid Waste Load

- Empty plastic tar and paint pails
- Caulk tubes
- Clothing
- Paper products
- Small plastics
- General household garbage
- Cardboard
- Carpet (in sections no larger than 3 square feet – additional charges may apply)

TYPE: Soft Goods Load

- Stuffed chairs
- Sofas
- Mattresses
- Carpet (rolled)

Items Not Accepted in Dumpsters and Roll-offs

Landfill Only Items:

- Treated lumber and treated wood scraps
- Televisions/electronics
- Appliances
- Scrap metal/water heaters
- Large plastics

Note: These items must be hauled directly to the Landfill. Per item charges apply.

Prohibited Items:

- Asbestos in any form
- Ashes or burned wood
- Liquid waste (paint, stains and lacquers, household cleaners)
- All other hazardous waste (pesticides, motor oil, glue, tar, solvents, caulk)

Note: The above lists are NOT all inclusive. If you have questions about whether or not specific waste will be accepted as Demolition Debris or Municipal Solid Waste, you should contact the City Landfill operators at 218-332-5860. If dumpsters or roll-offs require separating, you will be charged a fee and will also be subject to a fine.
