<u>Section 1.</u> City Code Chapter 7.22 (B)(7) is hereby amended as follows:

7.22 B-3, GENERAL BUSINESS DISTRICT.

(B)(7) Artists' and body art studios;

<u>Section 2.</u> City Code Chapter 7.57 (C) is hereby amended so as to add as follows:

7.57 INTERIM USE PERMITS.

(1)	No interim use permit may be issued within any residence dis
(2)	Business Districts:
	(a) B-1, no interim use permits allowed
	(b) B-2, no interim use permits allowed.
	(c) within a B-3, general business district, for warehousing/commercial indoor storage.
	(c) within a B-4, service- recreation business district, for warehousing/commercial indoor storage.
	(c) within a B-5 and B-6, shopping center business district warehousing/commercial indoor storage.
(3)	All industrial districts, for outdoor wood burning stoves.

Background

At the December Planning Commission meeting the Commission directed staff to prepare a text amendment to allow indoor commercial warehousing in the B 3 – B-6 zones via interim use permits. This was brought up as a potential use of property that are currently vacant and will allow a use until the buildings can have a retail use again. In January, city staff also had an inquiry about a body art studio (tattoo studio). This use wasn't directly listed in the B-3 zone, but artists studio is in the list. So, the amendment also adds "body" art to that use list in the B-3 zone which encompass the downtown area.
